The 'Intellectual Property (IP)' refers to various distinct types of creations of the mind: inventions, literary & artistic works and symbols, names, images and designs used in commerce; for which a set of exclusive rights like copyrights, trademarks, patents, industrial design rights and trade secrets are recognized under the corresponding fields of law. The AISSMS Institute of Management (IOM) has established Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell on 25th July 2017.

a) Objectives of IPR Cell:
