CODE OF CONDUCT TO CHECK MALPRACTICES AND PLAGARISM IN RESEARCH

The Institute believes in promoting a healthy research culture amongst the students/faculty and does not compromise with the malpractices and plagiarism with regard to project/research work. The Institute has established a Research & Publication Committee to facilitate, monitor and encourage the research and publication activities. The Committee is responsible for checking malpractices and plagiarism in research. The institution warns faculty & students to strictly prohibit plagiarism and consider it as an act of cheating, fraud, malpractice, misconduct and violation of code. The committee provides advice and guidance to the researchers on all matters pertaining to research ethics. The committee also advices the teachers doing research to adhere strictly the code of ethics to enhance the quality of the published work. The students/faculty members should practice following Code of Ethics:

- Academic integrity should be ensured in the research work.
- · The Institute strictly discourages dishonest and unethical practices in research.
- Students/faculty should be responsible for ensuring original research work.
- The Institute explicitly forbids plagiarism in research by students/faculty.
- Students should seek guidance from teachers in order to contribute for good research and avoid plagiarism.
- Any act of plagiarism would be liable of punishment as decided by the Research & Publication Committee and Director.
- The Institute adheres to follow the code of ethics for research/project work strictly.
